

VINCE VOCAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded in the name of the founding President of the Canadian National Federation of Independent Unions. Vince Vocal took the idea of combining the resources of a number of small independent unions to create a larger federation of unions. After years of dedication and hard work, his vision evolved in 1998 with the affiliation of CNFIU with LiUNA, creating a new entity that is now known as LiUNA Local 3000.

The Vince Vocal Scholarship is open to all members, immediate family members and grandchildren of members of LiUNA Local 3000, who are attending or have been accepted to a full-time post-secondary institution in Canada.

A one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) scholarship will be awarded to the successful applicant as chosen by the scholarship committee every year during the month of July.

A 500-1000 word essay describing "*Benefits of Unions*" shall be submitted for consideration by the Scholarship Selection Committee.

The scholarship recipient will be chosen by the Scholarship Selection Committee to be appointed by the Executive Board of LiUNA Local 3000.
